Understanding the Enrollment Process

Airmen on active duty are enrolled in the program when they have a family member, which includes spouses, children, and/or adult children with a physical, emotional, developmental, or intellectual disorder requiring specialized services so their needs can be considered in the military personnel assignment process.

Some examples are dependents that require:

- Special medical services for a chronic condition such as asthma, attention deficit disorder, diabetes, multiple sclerosis, etc.
- Ongoing services from a medical specialist
- Significant behavioral health treatment
- Early intervention or special education services through an individualized education program or individualized family service plan

The EFMP is a 3-Part Mandatory U.S. Department of Defense Enrollment Program that works with military and civilian agencies to provide support for special medical and educational needs.
