



## Eglin Recreational FAMCAMP Rules

Rules/Regulations are subject to change without prior notice from the FAMCAMP Manager. There is a NO TOLERANCE policy and we reserve the right to remove guests that do not abide by the rules. Air Force Campgrounds were developed for, and will be managed to support recreational camping purposes. They are not to be used as a place to live.

**RESERVATION POLICY:** Must be Active Duty, Retired Military, Military Dependent, DoD Civilians, Contractors, and 18 years of age. **Reservations must be reserved by the individual that will be occupying the site.** Campers **MAY NOT** hold a site for themselves, friends, or others. Holding a site will result in you and the other patron being asked to leave the FAMCAMP. **The campground reserves the right to relocate reserved sites.**

**CHECKIN/CHECKOUT:** Checkout time is 1200 and Check-in time is 1500. Guests must have all items cleared off site by 1200. Late checkout could result in an additional night's fee and refusal of payment will result in denial of any future reservation requests until payment is received by the FAMCAMP office.

**STAY:** Reservations for FAMCAMP sites may be made 120 days in advance for active duty and 90 in advance for all others. The Maximum length of continuous stay in Camp Robbins FAMCAMP is 120 days, Postl Point FAMCAMP 30 days, and all tent sites 30 days. Once a guest has reached the maximum continuous stay, they must depart the campground for 30 days before making another reservation. Under unique circumstances, an exception to policy may be granted and requests are to be routed through FSS Leadership.

**FEES AND PAYMENT:** All site rentals require a non-refundable deposit of \$80 for guests staying 29 nights or less and \$100 for guests staying 30 or more. Full payment for a campsite must be made one (1) day prior to check-in.

**Site Renewal:** Site renewal payments are due by the last date indicated on the guest's reservation receipt and must be paid no later than close of business on the last day of the site rental period. All long-term guests (guests staying 30 days or more) are required to make rental payments every 30 days.

**Late Fees:** If payment is not received by the due date a late fee of \$45 per day will be assessed until the site payment is received. After 2 late payments or 3 consecutive days of non-payment, the guest will be required to vacate the campground with no return rights. The collection amount will be calculated at the daily rate plus the late fee and will not cease until the renter has removed all personal items from the site and paid the applicable amount. It is the guest's responsibility to pay the rental fee on time. Guests departing early will not receive a refund. All sales are final.

**CANCELLATION POLICY/REFUNDS:** Guests may cancel their reservation up to two (2) days before the reservation date. If a refund is warranted, the guest will be issued a refund minus the deposit. Guests that cancel their reservation less than two days prior to their reservation will not be issued a refund. During your stay, refunds will only be given for a documented change in orders, deployments, moving into a house during PCS, evacuation, medical emergency, or death of registered guest or immediate family. Refunds will not be given for unused days.

If a long-term guest cancels the remainder of their stay, the economic benefit of the 30 day fee is forfeited when the guest cancels before the 30 days are utilized. The advertised daily camping fee will be charged retroactively from the date of check-in to the present check-out date.

**Subletting:** Guests are not permitted to sublet their assigned site or RV at any time.

**RV SITES:** Camp Robbins: Limit of 1 camper and 2 vehicles per site; Post'l Point FamCamp: 1 camper, 2 vehicle and 1 large item allowed per site. Vehicles are defined as truck, car, motorcycle, moped, golf cart, atv, or any other drivable device (kids toys are acceptable). Large items are defined as a cargo trailer, towing trailer, boat, or any rather trailered large item. **All vehicles and/or item must be parked single file in the site lane (gravel) in-line with the camper at all times.** Vehicles, or other large items parked on the grass or areas other than the site lane is not allowed. Motorcycles are not authorized to park on the cement pad. Guests taking their camper off site must take all belongings and must be clear of personal items. In the event of an evacuation, all campers will be required to depart the park. This includes RV, vehicles and all personal equipment/items. All guests must have the ability to move their RV (Camper) at all times

**TENTS SITES:** Two tents are allowed per site and must fit within designated area. Tents **ARE NOT** allowed on an RV site.

**PARKING:** Guests parking additional vehicles overnight or for more than a day will need to stop by the campground office or see the camp host for a parking pass. Overflow parking is \$2/day and behind the FAMCAMP next to the ball field. Post'l guests/visitors are to use parking lot located by Outdoor Recreation. Do not park in empty RV or tent sites.

**CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 10:** **Must have an adult present when playing outside** and should not be running around the campground unsupervised. Children should refrain from playing in roadways, woods, or in other guest's sites. Children are not allowed to take garbage to the dumpster by themselves. Children riding bikes are to be wearing helmets and have proper headlights, indicator lights, or reflective gear when riding during evening. The sponsor will be held responsible for any damage, destruction or harm caused to property or personnel by their child(ren).

**SITE APPEARANCE:** Guests will maintain an orderly site. Picnic pads will not be used as storage areas. Free-standing storage units are not permitted. **Campsite areas must be kept clean and free of clutter. All personal and recreational items must be stored in the camper or** stored under the camper and present a neat and orderly appearance. Guests are responsible for removing trash. **DO NOT** leave out any food items, bird feed, garbage, garbage cans, or other items that may attract mice, bears, etc. Outside refrigerators or freezers are not allowed. Coolers left outside need to be empty and stored under camper. No poles or large stakes can be driven into ground. Freestanding canopies, clotheslines, lattice/or homemade porches/patios, jungle gyms, fitness racks are not authorized on sites. Only exception is screened-in canopies.

**MAIL:** Do not use the campground office as a mailing address. FAMCAMP staff will not accept mail, postage or packages.

**SPEED LIMIT:** 5 MPH. Please be safe and use caution when driving through the campgrounds. Speeding will not be tolerated.

## Eglin Recreational FAMCAMP Rules

**QUIET HOURS:** All guests must observe quiet time from 2200-0700. The use of generators or other loud equipment is prohibited during these times. Stereo/TV volume should be kept low enough not to disturb your neighbors. Vehicles with loud exhausts are not to idle and are to follow quiet hours. The use of generators when there is no power is acceptable.

**CAMPGROUND COMMON AREAS:** The bathhouse and laundry area are for registered campground guests only. Laundry facilities, washing machines and dryers are for clothing and linen items only. Pet beds and large bulk items are not permitted to be washed/dried in the provided washer and/or dryers. The campground is a tobacco-free zone. Permitted use of tobacco products, vapes and dip, are authorized only in the assigned site for the guest. Guests will dispose of tobacco products safely and environmentally.

Propane containers, gas vessels, electronics, batteries, bulk items and furniture are not permitted to be put in or beside the dumpsters. Guests who violate disposal rules may be asked to vacate their site. The guest is responsible for damage to government property for negligent use.

The government is not responsible for damage to personal property.

**GRASS CUTTING/TRIMMING:** Long Term guests (guests over 30 days) are responsible for the grass cutting/trimming around their site. Lawn mowers/trimmers are available at the campground office for use. The campground office will issue a warning if sites are not maintained and after 2 warnings, you will be asked to vacate FAMCAMP.

**GRILLING/CAMPFIRES:** Outside cooking is restricted to propane or charcoal. All charcoal must be dumped in the appropriate dumpster at the front of the campground NOT in your campsite or woods. **NO OPEN FIRES ARE ALLOWED TO INCLUDE FIRE PITS.** This includes TIKI torches or any device that requires an open flame.

**PETS:** Must be kept on a leash at ALL times. **Pets cannot be left outside unattended at any time.** First time offenders will be warned. Second time offenders will be asked to vacate FAMCAMP. Pet waste must be picked up immediately. Dogs are not permitted to disturb other guests by continuous barking or howling. Tie-outs that present a safety concern are prohibited. Pets that demonstrate an aggressive behavior may be asked to leave the campground. Guests will not be accompanied by exotic animals such as, but not limited to: reptiles, rodents (other than hamsters and guinea pigs), ferrets, hedgehogs, skunks, rats, raccoons, squirrels, potbellied pigs, monkeys, arachnids, any farm animal, birds of prey, or exotic cats.

Camp Robbins: Dog runs tied to trees and pet fences/playpens are not permitted. Post'l Point FamCamp: Pet fences/playpens are permitted.

**CONDUCT:** Guests will refrain from irrational behavior to include profanity, threatening gestures, violence, or any other unwarranted behavior. This includes any actions or words that disturb the peace of other campers or interferes with FAMCAMP staff operation. Guests displaying such actions will be warned and may be asked to vacate the campground. Guests are also responsible and accountable for the actions of their children, dependents, and visitors.

Guests are prohibited from modifying the landscaping or natural environment in any manner. **Washing your RV/Camper, vehicle or any other item is prohibited** (water is specifically designed to provide water to your RV and may not be used as a hose or as a toy). Maintenance and repair of a POV is prohibited in the campground. No carpentry or woodworking is allowed. Fireworks and storing of hazardous material are not authorized on the premise at any time. Swimming is authorized in the bay at your own risk. No lifeguard on duty.

**FIREARMS:** The storing or introduction of a Privately Owned Firearm (POF) in the campground is prohibited. The only exception is for individuals who possess a valid Law Enforcement Officer Safety Act (LEOSA) credential who may retain one POF (handgun) for concealed carry purposes, these guests must comply with the requirements listed on the credentials.

**Emergency Procedures:** Guests will adhere to real-world and exercise emergency procedures.

**You must immediately inform the 96<sup>th</sup> Security Force Squadron at 882-2502 and the 96<sup>th</sup> Force Support Squadron ODR Director and/or FAMCAMP Manager before arrival if you or your guests have been convicted or are pending conviction of a drug related offense or are a registered sex offender or predator.**

Federal Law regarding medical marijuana or any other illegal drugs: Cannabis is illegal on the national level. This means it is illegal to consume marijuana in its national parks, forests, federal wildlife, and any other federal properties that are under federal law. If you are caught with any type of drugs other than prescription drugs, you will be asked to leave the campground and the Security Forces will be notified. Smoking is not allowed in restrooms or laundry facilities.

It is your responsibility to adhere to all installation policies while on Eglin AFB. **Your stay may be discontinued at any time if a lack of accordance is demonstrated for any of the above-cited responsibilities while you are a guest at our FAMCAMP.**

**By accepting to stay at Eglin FAMCAMP (Camp Robbins and/or Post'l Point), the paying guest is accepting to abide by and follow the above rules set forth by Eglin FAMCAMP. The paying guest agrees to assume all risks and responsibilities associated with the use of any Eglin FAMCAMP facility, including but not limited to bodily injury, death, or damage to property. The paying guest agrees not to sue and to forever release, hold harmless, indemnify and defend the United States Government, Eglin Air Force Base Outdoor Recreation staff, Non-Appropriated Funds Instrumentalities and/or any other United States Government agency, organization, their officers, members, agents, employees and volunteers (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all present and future liability, claims, demands, losses or damages in any way related to my use of the Eglin Air Force Base Outdoor Recreation facilities, equipment rentals and/or my participation in Outdoor Recreation activities and programs. If the paying guest's, heirs, administrators, executors or assigns should demand, claim, sue, or aid in any way such demand, claim, or suit, the paying guest agrees for their self myself, their heirs, administrators, executors, and assigns to forever indemnify the Indemnified Parties for all damages, expenses and costs it may incur as a result thereof.**
