## PRIVATE PILOT COURSE

The FAA approved Part 141 Private Pilot Course requires a minimum of 35 hours flight time. Our Part 141 ground school is 100% online and access to the course is available for 1 year.

## COMMERCIAL PILOT COURSE

After successfully completing the Private Pilot Course, pilots may move on to an instrument rating and Commercial Pilot License. Both are required for employment as a pilot.

### INSTRUMENT RATING

The FAA Instrument Rating course requires 35 hours minimum of dual instruction. Ground school is conducted in conjunction with the flight course.

## FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Pilots who want to become a flight instructor can receive training to get the Certified Flight Instructor rating.

### MILITARY COMPETENCY

Military pilots can obtain their commercial and instrument or instructor ratings by successfully completing and passing the military competency exams.

### Army IgnitED, Navy COOL, and Marine Corps COOL

Check with your Education office about available benefits. Credentialing assistance can be used for the A&P course.
